Last year around this time Nery came to House of Destiny a scared and scarred three-year-old little boy. You may remember he came to us from the hospital after being caught alone in a house fire. I remember the first doctor appointment couple days after he arrived, and how the doctor had to cut off flesh and dead tissue as he screamed on the table.

Nery's mother was not able to care for him and take him to his many doctor appointments so we received him into House of Destiny knowing that when she was able Nery's mother would get custody. We see in Hebrews 11 that it takes faith to please God and what are we doing in Guatemala if we are not endeavoring to please Him? We took Nery into House of Destiny knowing it would be for a short time but also knowing he needed our faith.

I am ecstatic to tell you that I can see the goodness of God in that smile and he knows Jesus as Healer and Savior. God is good and He sent His Word to heal us all!
